We have been working to revive an RMOTHG Nordic skiing program, both on easy backcountry trails and at Nordic centers. We are currently limited in terms of qualified Nordic XC Trip Leaders, but hope to alleviate that problem in early January, and start posting weekday trips announcements. There are three things that we ask of you.
