ATTENTION: Winter Trip Leaders

The Avalanche Terrain Avoidance (ATA) course is a basic seminar and 1/2 field-day to help you recognize when and where avalanche danger may exist and how to avoid it. Sources of information and methods for planning avalanche-safe routes will be presented. Find out more **HERE**.

ATA is recommended for all CMC trip leaders (regardless of sport or season) and **required** for leaders who travel in snow-covered areas but do not travel in avalanche-prone terrain.

AIARE Level 1 (or equivalent) is required for trip leaders who travel in avalanche prone terrain.

2025 Telemark Ski School

The Telemark Ski School - Denver Group has over 40 years of providing quality instruction to hundreds of students from all over Colorado and beyond! We help beginner, intermediate, and advanced-level telemark skiers learn and/or improve their telemark skiing skills.

The 2025 Telemark Ski School (TSS) offers **3 individual Sunday sessions: January 26, February 9, and February 23**; all sessions take place at Loveland Ski Area. For each session,

you'll be grouped with others of like ability and assigned your instructor for the day. The second and third TSS sessions in February may find you in a higher-level class, dependent on your practice and improvement from previous session(s).

The best way to use the School is to take at least two of the sessions and practice in-between. But taking all three is even better! This is YOUR year for telemark skiing--come join the fun!
